# **Writing Aloha**

"I feel most at home when I'm amongst the trees, plants, mountains, and by the ocean or in wide open spaces," said Spencer. "In fact, I feel so connected when I'm in the natural world I can literally 'feel' the energy. I find it inspiring, empowering, and the perfect place where I can allow my mind to be quiet to entertain the creative thoughts that pop into my head."

"My feelings about nature, as well as my interest in sustainable living practices, which include eating fresh, organic and farm to table, and protecting the earth's environment for future generations, is directly in line to what the Hawaiians believe and practice living the "The Way of Aloha" or in the "Spirit of Aloha," which is why I feel such an affinity to Hawaii.

"The word Aloha is rich with meaning," continued Spencer. "It means with love and affection when a person says 'hello' or bids a person farewell, and it's also a way of interacting with the natural world by a certain code of ethics, which includes, but is not limited to: love, kindness, tolerance, compassion, respect, and honor of all humanity and living things. It encompasses the thoughtful and deliberate preservation of the earth and its precious resources and the 'conscious

manifestation' to live life joyfully in the present. In fact, in 1986, Hawaiian lawmakers passed the 'Aloha Spirit' law (Hawai'i Revised Statutes, section 5-7.5), inspired by the late Hawaiian teacher, poet and philosopher, Auntie Pilahi Paki's translation of the meaning of the word." "I knew I wanted to incorporate the aloha philosophy in 'Lady in the Window,' as a means for Kate to help heal herself and find her center. "Her journey continues in 'The Paradise Table.""

"I'm committed to writing the themes of Aloha," continued Spencer. "Whether it be in a novel, movie or television screenplay, or in my work as a food and lifestyle journalist, radio and TV host, or on my *Simply Delicious Living* blog."

In "The Paradise Table" (SelectBooks, 2018), Spencer's sequel to her award-winning novel, "Lady in the Window" (SelectBooks, 2017), two of the recurring main characters — Kate Grace, a just-married, successful freelance lifestyle writer and hopeful author, and Olivia Larkin, a vivacious, African-American entertainment icon, media mogul, and philanthropist, who share the same beliefs about living Aloha, find themselves witness to a violent act that shatters the quiet serenity of their lives. Still grieving and rocked by recent events, Kate must tap into her intuition to understand synchronicities sent from beyond to bring peace and healing to her family, friends, community... and to herself.

"Both my characters Kate and Olivia believe that love never dies and that our loved ones surround and guide us and in "The Paradise Table," these intuitions and synchronicities help guide them both to the truth, and essentially, more healing.

"As humans, I believe that we're all connected and that as we live and navigate life, we're constantly learning, changing, and healing as we grow," said Spencer. "A vital part of our journey on earth is to learn to love and help one another. If we incorporate the sentiments of aloha in our heart and our thoughts and actions, we can all make a valuable difference in this world."
