The Paradise Table is another Kate Grace Mystery and Spencer's follow up to her award-winning novel, Lady in the Window (SelectBooks, 2017; Santa Rosa Press, 2019). In the book, two of the recurring main characters — Kate Grace, a just-married, successful freelance lifestyle writer and hopeful author, and Olivia Larkin, a vivacious, African-American entertainment icon, media mogul, and philanthropist, find themselves witness to a violent act that shatters the quiet serenity of their lives. A shocking series of events are set in motion that lead to the confrontation of a devastating, decades-held secret. Still grieving and rocked by recent events, Kate taps into her intuition, dreams, and prayers to understand synchronicities sent from beyond with the hopes of bringing peace and healing to her family, friends, community... and to herself.

"Both my characters, Kate and Olivia, believe that love never dies and that, with God's grace, we get divine inspirations validating that we are not alone.

"As humans, I believe that we're all connected and that as we live and navigate life, we're constantly learning, changing, and healing as we grow," said Spencer. "A vital part of our journey on earth is to learn to love and help one another. If we incorporate the sentiments of Aloha in our heart and our thoughts and actions, we can all make a valuable difference in this world."
